**will be accepted on a first come, first served basis as registration forms with entry fees are received at the above address. Negative Coggins papers are required on ALL horses. All paperwork must be in order!**

## ***Wild West Days Ranch Rodeo Rules***

Any unnecessary roughness or abuse of ***any*** animal in ***any event*** will result in disqualification of the team in that event.

***The Judges decision is final. No exceptions!! Any excessive arguing or use of profanity will also result in disqualification.***

***No talking to the judge during another teams run.***

PLACING FOR ALL EVENTS WILL BE DETERMINED ON A POINT SYSTEM:

Place points through 10<sup>th</sup> place in each event

Teams must qualify in all three events of the preliminary rounds to advance to finals. Then top four pointed teams advance.

### ***Trailer Loading***

1-1/2 Minute time limit

10 calves numbered 0-9

3 Riders begin on horseback, any number may dismount.

Time begins when first rider crosses time line

No roughing the calves {e.g. running over calf with horse} Judges decision is final

No roping of the calf

Correct numbered calf only, must be loaded when time is called no trash

Close end gate and latch properly then run and tear ribbon from fence. Whoever latches the gates must be the one who tears the ribbon. The latch-man must be ***clearly*** identifiable.

### ***Branding***

1-1/2 minute time limit

2 Ropers on horseback/1 Brander on foot

10 calves Numbered 0-9

Limit of total of 4 throws per team; Catch as catch can, calf may be heeled as desired

Riders may carry two ropes

No dragging of calf, once you dally you must stop the horse!!

2nd rider may leave horse and hold or throw calf if desired

Brander must have one hand on the fence until rope is dallied.

Brander must run to calf, and use the branding-iron to place a distinctly visible mark on either hip of calf. Once brand is placed the rope must be removed from the calf before the brander pulls the ribbon to stop time.

Time is called when brander returns to starting point and pulls the ribbon off the fence.

### ***Ranch Sorting***

1-1/2 minute time limit

A herd of 10 calves numbered 0-9 will be held behind a time line

2 team members from previous team will settle herd

As riders approach the line, the announcer will call a number, which has been drawn for them. Time begins when first rider crossed the line. All riders may cross the line, and any rider may cut the calves.

The team has 90 seconds to cut and sort calves in a sequential pattern starting with their assigned number. Any wrong order or loss of sorted stock results in disqualification.

Times stops at 90sec. or when the last calf crosses the line.

The team with the most correctly numbered calves sorted and the fastest time wins.

## **Top Four Teams Advance to Clean Slate Finals**

Teams must qualify in all three events of the preliminary rounds, followed by highest point value.

Finals events: Trailer loading, Branding, and Steer mugging.

### **Steer Mugging**

**THIS EVENT WILL BE HELD DURING THE FINALS ONLY.**

2 minute time limit; all three team members must actively participate

All teams will run (circumstances day of show may change dependent on team's members)

A steer will be assigned to each team by draw.

Steers will be loaded into a bucking chute with a halter and lead rope in place. At the whistle, they will open the chute and the team must saddle their steer in the designated area for saddling; with both a pad and saddle.

One team member will mount and ride the steer across the time line. The other two members may lead or push the steer on foot.

If the saddle falls off or if the rider falls/gets bucked off, team must return to the designated area for saddling to adjust the saddle and/or remount.

The rider must sit on the animal independently. No other team members can touch the rider and/or saddle once the rider is mounted; Contact will result in disqualification

Fastest time wins.

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**Winners of the finals will place according to the fastest combined times of all three events.**

**Rules and events may be modified based on discussion and COLLECTIVE DECISION of the WWD Rodeo Committee up to the end of Saturday's preliminary meeting. All changes will be maintained throughout the weekend.**

**Check in at the Vernon County Fair Ground 7am to 8am both days; Friday**

**evening at the WWD grounds. Contestant meeting at 0830 sat and sun.  
Causal dress for preliminaries, western dress for finals.  
No like teams; "ie" Amy Nichols and Rosa Dilley may only team once even  
if the third member is different. Limit of two teams; entries may open day of  
event if space allows.**

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY  
AGREEMENT**

**IN CONSIDERATION** of being permitted to enter any purpose any **RESTRICTED AREA** (herein defined as including but not limited to the rodeo arena, competition area, chutes, pens areas reserved and intended for participants or restricted to the general public, and all walkways, concessions and other areas appurtenant to any area where and activity related to the event shall take place), or being permitted to compete, officiate, observe, work for, or for any purpose participate in any way in the event, **EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED**, for him/herself, his/her personal representatives, heirs, and next of kin, acknowledges, agrees and represents that he/she has, or will immediately upon entering any of such restricted area or areas, and will continuously thereafter, inspect such restricted areas and all portions thereof which he/she enters and with which he comes in contact, and he/she does further warrant that his/her entry upon such restricted area or areas and his/her participation, if any, in the event constitutes and acknowledgement that he/she has inspected such restricted area that he/she finds and accepts the same as being safe and reasonably suited for the purposes of his/her use, and he/she further agrees and warrants that if, at any time, he/she is in or about restricted area and he/she feels anything to be unsafe, he/she will immediately advise the officials of such and will leave the restricted areas.

**1. HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND CONVENANTS NOT TO SUE** the participants, sanctioning organization or any subdivision thereof, rodeo committee, stock contractor, rodeo association, arena operator or owners, city of Viroqua, officials, any persons in any restricted area, promoters, sponsors, advertisers, owners and lessees of premises used to conduct the event and each of them, their officers and employees, all for the purposes herein referred to as “releasees”, from liability to the undersigned, his personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin for any and all loss or damage, and any claim or demands thereof on account of **INJURY** or **DEATH** to the undersigned is in or upon the restricted area, and/or, competing, officiating in, observing, working for, any purpose

participating in the event.

**2. HEREBY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS** the release and each of them for and loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur due to the presence of the undersigned in or upon the restricted area or in any way competing, officiating, observing, or working for, or for any purpose participating in the event and whether caused by negligence of the releasees or otherwise.

**3. HEREBY ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR AND RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE** due to negligence of releases of otherwise while in or upon the restricted area and/or while competing, officiating, observing or working for or for any purpose participating in the event.

**EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED** expressly acknowledges and agrees that the activities of the event are very **DANGEROUS** and **INVOLVES RISK** of **SERIOUS INJURY** and/or **DEATH** and/or property damage. **EACH OF**

**THE UNDERSIGNED** further expresses that the foregoing release, waiver, and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by law of the Province or State in which the event is conducted and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

**THE UNDERSIGNED HAS READ AND VOUNTARILY SIGNS THE RELEASE AND WAIVER OF**

**LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT**, and further agrees that no oral representations, statements or inducements apart from the foregoing written agreement have been made.

**UNDERSTAND AND I ASSUME ALL RISK IN RODEO.**
